BBSC DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES Page 1 of 2

Ballet Balance Skateboard Club (BBSC) is a regimented and technical ballet balance enhancement and freestyle skateboard training program for women. The athletes learn the necessary foot and whole body balance positions incrementally, step by step, according to their ability, and lesson plan. Training boards without wheels, and anchored boards with wheel restraints are used first in the lesson plans to build up the dance athlete's confidence to start pushing safely. All equipment except for personal helmet, wrist guards and uniform is provided to each athlete.

The club membership is seasonal and spans one year in three terms, and an optional summer camp. There are a total of 36 rehearsal practice sessions lasting 55 minutes each. The club's season is September to June and respects all holidays of the team members for inclusion and recognition.

The club is insured for four teams of eight Participants. Currently only 32 dance athlete club members are protected under the insurance coverage. BBSC coverage is expandable when enough new selected Participants apply for a team position. The selected new Participants can create additional teams in groups of eight. The cost of membership to the new teams is according to the season cost of that year.

This program requires the transfer of ballet grace and positions to the sport of freestyle skateboarding while at the same time mastering the correct ballet form and movement for professional ballet company acceptance. All safe and easy maneuvers and tricks will be learned with ballet balance positioning and fluid graceful movements.

There are no dangerously difficult skateboard balance maneuvers or tricks in the first year of team membership. Dance athletes are expected to focus all their efforts on balance training to perform better as a ballerina or ballet dance athlete. The safety of the Participants is a main priority.

There are two coaches: one for skateboarding, and the other for ballet. The two coaches work together to allow each athlete to focus on the athlete's strengths rather than weaknesses.

The rehearsal practice sessions are held inside the Raincity Dance Ballet School in Vancouver. The indoor nature of the program allows "dry flat land ballet freestyle practice sessions" in all weather conditions, year round. Do not delay registering for this pioneer program of balance ability training and conditioning.

MEMBERSHIP SERVICES SUMMARY

Ballet balance strength conditioning for women using Indoor freestyle skateboarding.

All specialized balance training decks, mats, and boards are included; a personal certified helmet, wrist guards, and uniform is the Participant's responsibility.

Two Coaches at every practice session: one for ballet, and the other for skateboarding.

Four teams of eight Participants, attending 36 practice sessions over the season.

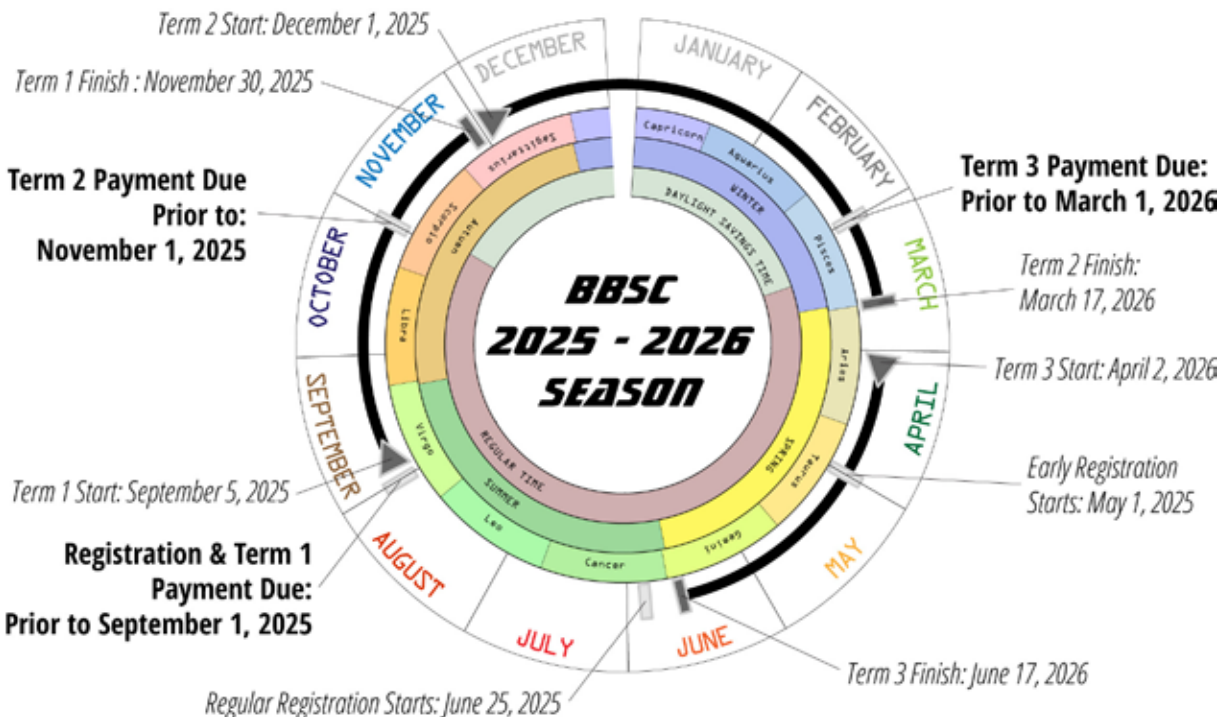

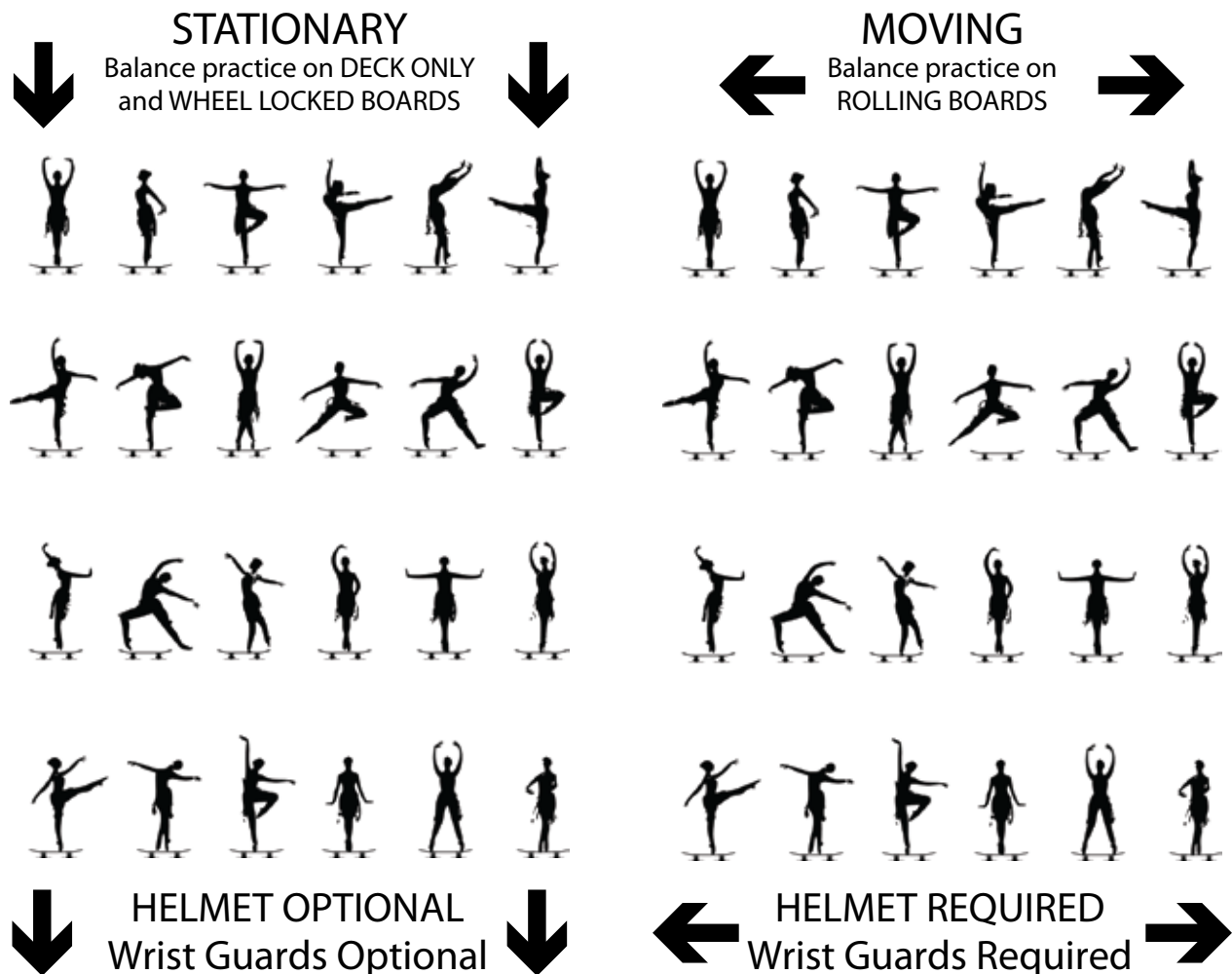
HELMET AND WRIST GUARD POLICY FOR ALL CLUB REHERSAL PRACTICE SESSIONS AND PERFORMANCES

To ensure the highest level of safety, it is mandatory for all participants must wear a properly fitting, non-damaged, certified helmet inside training, performance and competition areas when on a rolling skateboard. This helps to protect club members the event of a direct or in-direct hit to the head during rehersal practice training sessions, performances and competitions. It is mandatory for all participants to correctly wear a properly fitting, non-damaged, certified helmet during all rolling excercises.

Helmets must be Certified as **ASTM-F-1492** or **BS EN 1385:2012** there are no exceptions.

BBSC Members receive discounted helmet and wrist guards from the club or they can purchase from any retailer.

NOTE: Helmets and wrist guards are only manditory when on a “rolling skateboard” and are optional when practicing on a “BBSC training deck or wheel locked board”. The policy is described graphically below.

REGISTRATION

All students must enrol and physically sign the Application Form, Membership Agreement, and waiver, in this document. Everything needed to be reviewed and signed by the Dance Athlete and Parent/Guardian is included in this printed PDF Membership Package. ***There is nothing else to be signed outside of this membership application.***

DOCUMENTATION AND REGISTRATION FEE

All the documents in this package must be signed prior to the first official team rehearsal practice session.

Membership fees must be paid at time of enrolment to guarantee a spot on a team. Preferred payment method is e-transfer, we also accept cash or cheque. We only accept debit and credit card payments through the online portal.

A non-refundable registration fee is due at the time of registration. Membership fees are payable in advance of each term on the stated due dates, unless other arrangements have been agreed upon. Overdue membership fees may result in the student's not being admitted to sessions and the inability to purchase performance tickets.

There will be a \$50.00 charge on all returned cheques.

Club membership fees do not include fees for costumes, competitions, workshops or summer school programs. They do include all specialized ballet balance skateboards, mats, and training decks used in the rehearsal practice sessions. Dance athletes are responsible for their own personal certified helmet, wrist guards, and uniform.

COMPETITIONS

Should you wish to participate in future competitions, there are additional fees associated. Competition Administration fee \$200 per dance athlete includes Coaching, Run Choreography, and Administration for 2 local events TBA.

CANCELLED / DROPPED SESSIONS

Withdrawal from sessions (Leave the team) requires 14 days email notice, the athlete may continue to attend sessions in that time period; refunds will be given for the sessions paid for that fall after the 14 day time period. A full refund will be given if an accepted applicant withdraws two weeks prior to the start of the season, minus the registration fee.

There are no dropped session fees if switching from one team to another. No refunds will be given for ordered helmets, wrist guards, uniforms, costumes, recital photos and videos, or competition entry fees.

TEAM PLACEMENT

Ages are a guideline, students will be placed at the discretion of the coaches.

BBSC MEMBERSHIP POLICIES Page 3 of 5**TRY OUT SESSION**

If there is a team member vacancy, and you are invited, you can try a Ballet Balance Skateboard Club Team Try Out Session before registering, provided you sign up via email, online or in-studio 48 hours prior to the try out session. There is no charge for the session but you must be in uniform and sign the tryout waiver, (no helmet or wrist guards are required for the try out session).

If you are accepted to a team, and continue and join the team, the initial try out session will be free and not included in your yearly membership fee. If you are not accepted to a team vacancy, you will be placed on a waiting list for another team try out session when open. There is no fee for the team try out sessions. There is a limit of one Try Out Session for each team to a maximum of one per member applicant.

LATE REGISTRATION

Ballet Balance Skateboard Club annual membership runs from September to June. If you didn't register and/or have a try out session audition before September, you are not too late to join the Club. Depending on when you are inquiring about a try out session audition, we may be able to assist with registration after September, by forming another team of late registration athletes. Please firstly call or text 604-732-5867 or secondly send a request to info@balletbalance.org regarding your eligibility.

STUDIO ETIQUETTE

All students are expected to treat BBSC staff and peers with respect and courtesy during rehearsal practice sessions and on the premises. Any student who fails to comply with reasonable rules of conduct or demonstrates disruptive behavior in classes will get one warning before being dismissed from the session in accordance with the dropped session fee.

SESSION INSTRUCTORS

Substitute coaches may be called upon to cover a class for numerous reasons. BBSC reserves the right to make changes to the coaches of sessions if necessary throughout the year. If you have an issue with a particular coach please speak to the management about your concerns, however; if you wish to withdraw from the session the dropped session fee will be implemented.

PARKING

Ballet Balance Skateboard Club has free two hour underground parking for athletes and parent/guardians. There are two entrances: one on Cambie Street and one on Ash Street. Keep your parking ticket and validate it before leaving. Even though the mall has security patrol and cameras everywhere, use common sense never leave exposed items in your vehicle before you leave your car.

STANDARD BALLET STYLE UNIFORM DRESS CODE

Traditional and proper dance attire allows instructors to observe posture and proper body placement, and allow the dance athletes to train safely during rehearsal, practice sessions, providing a protocol of discipline. Teams can be made up of dance athletes from different schools and different levels of ballet experience. For this reason any solid color leotard or body suit is permitted. This is different from traditional ballet training with coordinated class uniforms because BBSC dance athletes are encouraged to build and maintain a positive self esteem; and by wearing the leotard of her choice adds to her identity as an individual, and her freedom of choice, and expression.

BBSC MEMBERSHIP POLICIES Page 4 of 5**BALLET UNIFORM DETAILS**

Top: Any solid color snug fitting leotard or bodysuit (existing or previous class leotard or body suit is fine no need to purchase new unless needed or desired.)

Bottom: Regular or convertible ballet tights, dance skirt optional.

Footwear: Split sole ballet slippers – Black, canvas or leather

ALTERNATIVE DRESS CODE: BALLET SKATEBOARD SPORT FITNESS STYLE

As an alternative to the traditional ballet leotard and tights, team members can wear snug white leggings and a sports top instead. This provides freedom of choice for the balance training uniform policy and is an acceptable uniform for rehearsal practice sessions.

SKATEBOARD SPORT UNIFORM DETAILS

Top: Any solid color snug fitting dance, sport, or yoga style top (existing or previous tops are fine, no need to purchase new unless needed or desired.)

Bottom: Solid white leggings (footed or footless), dance skirt optional.

Footwear: Split sole ballet slippers – Black, canvas or leather

An approved uniform must be worn to classes and no other attire will be accepted. Students desiring sponsorship for competitions should purchase a minimum of two of each required item and enough pairs of tights/leggings to ensure they have clean uniforms for every rehearsal practice session.

Please note that for all dance classes hair must be pulled back. Because helmets are used in the training sessions the classical hair bun using hairspray, hairnets, and bun pins is not required for any rehearsal practice session. For all classes slicked back ponytail or braiding is acceptable.

UNIFORM FOR GROUP TRY OUT AUDITION

BBSC requires that dancer students from other countries make a video in uniform and send it in, and local students come to a free group tryout audition in the proper clothing attire. Please review the Dress Code above.

BBSC DISCOUNTS

BBSC a discount code/coupon is provided by email or by text message to purchase essential items from participating dance supply shops.

ADDITIONAL POLICIES

BBSC will publish selection criteria for all team programs on the Ballet Balance Skateboard Club web site.

Ballet Balance Skateboard Club shall post an athlete status report of Club Athletes from time to time.

BBSC will publish selection criteria for the Athlete Assistance Program (AAP) on the Ballet Balance Skateboard Club web site when available at least 3 months prior to the start of the next AAP cycle.

BBSC will provide an appeal procedure that is in conformity with the principles of natural justice, common sense, and procedural fairness, which shall include access to independent arbitration through the Sport Dispute Resolution Centre of Canada (SDRCC).

BBSC will provide educational materials and resources on the doping rules of the Canadian Centre for Ethics in Sport (CCES).

Participants must be a member in good standing of Ballet Balance Skateboard Club. They must also actively participate in all training rehearsal practice sessions, competitive activities, evaluation activities and reporting procedures of the club, pay membership dues, health and accident insurance fees when applicable and membership levies associated with training and competition.

BBSC will use the Discipline and Complaints Policy for remedy of complaints and issues especially where the situation involves the conduct or performance a BBSC employed staff member or coach.

The Participant is responsible for the club studio practice uniform, performance leotard or costume, and protective gear that the Participant will wear during rehearsal practice sessions and official events.

Disputes will be resolved according the Membership Agreement.

BBSC will develop a high performance committee to help enable selected dance athletes apply for government funding in the future.

Ballet Balance Skateboard Club's Discipline and Complaints Policy: If any Coach, or High Performance Committee Member and/or any other Representative of Ballet Balance Skateboard Club is in breach of any of the provisions of this information package, the dance athlete can notify an Executive Committee member or Executive Director in writing.

COACHING STAFF INFORMATION**KELLY ALM (Skateboarding)**

Kelly is one of Vancouver's skateboard pioneers who helped to make the sport legal and accepted. Born in Vancouver then raised in California, Kelly started skating at age 13. Upon moving back to Vancouver in grade 8, he was instrumental in the development of Vancouver's freestyle and street style skateboarding scenes. Kelly ran the Skate Safe program for the False Creek Community Center and organized the Ranch Style Skateboard contest on the Granville Island Water Park which was one of the first street style skateboarding competitions in Canada.

Over his 44 years of skateboarding experience, he has been a strong advocate for skateboarding's acceptance, safety and park development in Vancouver and brings a wealth of experience and patience to his coaching. He has the designation of Trained Skateboard Community Coach from the National Coach Certification Program under the Canada Skateboard Pathway.

BEN CHIBBER (Skateboarding)

Ben is a celebrated figure in the Canadian skateboarding scene, renowned for his ground breaking contributions to the sport. Born and raised in Vancouver, his journey in skateboarding began in June of 1985. His passion and determination on the board garnered attention, leading to sponsorships by prestigious California companies such as Vision Skateboards, A-1 Meats Wheels, and Gullwing Trucks in the late '80s and early '90s. Notably, Ben Chibber was the first Canadian skateboarder to grace the back cover of Transworld Skateboarding Magazine, a testament to his influence, dedication, and impact on the global skateboarding community.

In addition to his achievements as a skateboarder, Ben Chibber was dedicated to sharing his passion for skateboarding with others. In 2009, he opened the only indoor skateboard park in Vancouver, BC, called the Dryspot Indoor Skatepark, where he served as an instructor offering lessons, and spring, summer, and fall camps. With over 24 years of experience, His impact continues to inspire generations of skateboarders, shaping the landscape of Canadian skateboarding culture for years to come. Ben is currently working towards his NCCP Skateboard Coach designation.

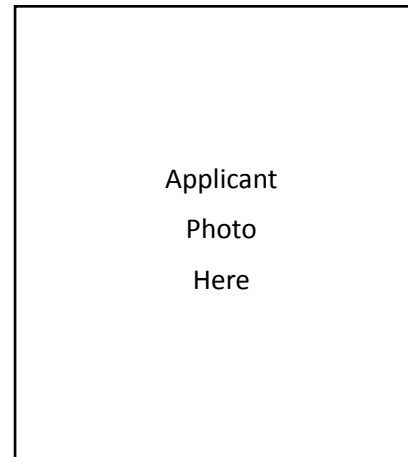

Skateboarding can be dangerous. Your participation and club membership requires that you fill in the Application Form and sign the Membership Agreement and Waiver that follows and abide by the terms of the Application Form, Membership Agreement, and Waiver.

Your membership requires legally binding agreements and acknowledgements between you and BBSC. If you do not understand the contents of the application Form, Membership Agreement, or Waiver you may wish to consult with a lawyer. Please read this document carefully, as by filling in the form, signing the membership agreement, and waiver, you are confirming that you have read and understood them.

Two copies are provided for your initials and signature. Initial at the bottom of each page and sign the two copies of the Membership Agreement and Waiver with a witness, and return them both, to the head coach at the studio or by mail to: BBSC 520 7th Avenue West, Unit 407, Vancouver B.C. V5Z 1B3. Once all the Agreements have been counter signed by Ballet Balance Skateboard Club, one of your original signed copies will be returned to you immediately in person, or by mail for your records.

WHEREAS BBSC is recognized by Canada Skateboard as a specialized skateboarding club for women;

AND WHEREAS BBSC organizes Clubs to teach ballet balance skateboarding in Canada;

AND WHEREAS the Participant has been selected to, and wishes to be an active participant of the Club;

AND WHEREAS BBSC and the Participant wish to clarify the relationship between them by establishing their respective obligations;

NOW THEREFORE in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements hereinafter contained within this agreement and for other good and valuable consideration, the parties hereby agree as follows:

DEFINITIONS

1. IN THIS AGREEMENT, THE FOLLOWING WORDS WILL HAVE THE FOLLOWING MEANINGS SET OUT HEREIN:

- a) "Agreement" means this written agreement;
- b) "BBSC" means Ballet Balance Skateboard Club.
- c) "Club" means the Club of instruction, practice, and competition, for and of the Participant teams of BBSC representing BBSC and Canada at designated skateboarding and dance competitions;
- d) "Head Coach" means the national coach designated from time to time by BBSC;
- e) "Participant" means the above named Participant who is participating in any of BBSC's Club activities;
- f) "Policies" means all the policies as listed in BBSC's membership package;
- g) "Releasees" means Ballet Balance Skateboard Club including their respective directors, officers, representatives, employees, agents, independent contractors, practice space providers, sponsors, volunteers, successors and assigns.

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OBLIGATIONS OF BBSC

2. BBSC WILL:

- a) Invite, select and prepare Participants to represent Canada in international skateboarding competitions in accordance with the budget and Policies of BBSC.
- b) Provide administrative services to suit the reasonable needs of the Participant, in accordance to the budget and Policies of BBSC.
- c) Plan and manage training Clubs and competitive activities for the ongoing development of Participants and the Club in accordance with the budget and Policies of BBSC.
- d) Register selected Participants in local, national and international events in which the Club will be attending, in accordance with the budget and Policies of BBSC.
- e) Provide funding for travel, accommodation and meal expenses of Participants participating in training and competitive activities of the Club in accordance with the budget and Policies of BBSC.
- f) Provide, at its cost or at the Participant's cost, accident insurance for the Participant while competing as part of the Club, in accordance with the budget and Policies of BBSC.
- g) Provide team uniforms, apparel, products and other equipment that BBSC requests from Participants to wear, in accordance with the budget and Policies of BBSC. This does not include studio practice uniform, performance leotard, costume, or protective gear that the Participant will wear during practices and official events.
- h) Assist the Participant in obtaining appropriate sport science expertise and medical care to the best of their ability and in accordance with the budget of BBSC. All demands of assistance should be answered in a timely fashion according to the circumstances.
- i) Respect the confidentiality of medical information supplied by the Participant to BBSC's medical staff by not supplying this information to outside parties without consent of the Participant, unless required to do so by law or in accordance with the Canadian Sport anti-doping policies.
- j) Make available through BBSC's website copies of all BBSC Policies, as amended, pertaining to the Club.
- k) Provide an appeal procedure that is in conformity with the principles of natural justice and procedural fairness, which shall include access to independent arbitration through the Sport Dispute Resolution Centre of Canada (SDRCC). Publish the details of this procedure in a prominent manner so that it is freely available to all Participants or any person requesting this information by or on behalf of the Participant.
- l) Provide educational materials and resources on the doping rules of the CCES.
- m) Communicate with Participants both orally and in writing in the language of their choice (French or English).
- n) Publish selection criteria for all Clubs on the BBSC web site. BBSC shall post a Participant status report of Club Participants.
- o) Publish selection criteria for the Participant Assistance Club (AAP) on the BBSC web site at least 3 months prior to the start of the next AAP cycle.
- p) Where possible, provide the Participant with other reasonable assistance.

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OBLIGATIONS OF THE PARTICIPANT

3. THE PARTICIPANT WILL:

- a) Maintain status as a member in good standing of BBSC; abide by all policies, rules and regulations of BBSC; promptly pay all membership dues, health and accident insurance fees when applicable and Club levies associated with training and competition as approved by BBSC.
- b) Hereby warrant that she is a Canadian citizen, or is otherwise eligible to compete for Canada according to BBSC regulations in effect from time to time and that, if the Participant's status changes, the Participant shall forthwith inform BBSC.
- c) Provide BBSC with contact information including: mailing address; telephone number; email address; fax number and cell phone number for the delivery of BBSC's mailings and notices; and provide BBSC with any information which may be requested in order to confirm eligibility of the Participant and test for doping infractions.
- d) Actively participate in all training sessions, competitive activities, evaluation activities, and reporting procedures of the Club under the supervision of the Head Coach.
- e) Avoid any action or conduct that would reasonably be expected to significantly disrupt or interfere with a competition or the preparation for themselves or of any Participant for a competition.
- f) Demonstrate commitment to individual training sessions.
- g) If carded in practice, events or competition, demonstrate commitment to individual training sessions developed in consultation with the Head Coach (and/or designate) and maintain regular contact with the Head Coach (and/or designate) regarding progress in training.
- h) If carded, actively participate in all AAP evaluation activities. Participants will co-operate fully in any evaluation of the AAP that may be conducted by the Minister or anyone authorized to act on the Minister's behalf and provide such data as the person conducting the evaluation considers necessary for the proper conduct of the evaluation.
- i) Present training logs when requested by the coaching staff.
- j) Avoid living in an environment or undertaking in activities which are not conducive to high performance achievement or which pose significant risks to the Participant's health or ability to perform, as reasonably determined by BBSC.
- k) At the earliest possible date, notify the Head Coach in writing of any injury or other legitimate reason that will prevent the Participant from fulfilling any obligations under this Agreement. In the event of injury, the Participant will supply BBSC with a certificate from a medical doctor describing the nature of the injury within one week of the diagnosis of the injury.
- l) Provide pertinent medical information to the Head Coach.
- m) Wear and/or use products as directed by BBSC while engaged in any Club related athletic or athletic-related activities including competition, opening and closing ceremonies, post-competition ceremonies, press conferences, photo sessions, promotional events, and other public appearances; at all times and in the proper manner as directed by BBSC. This does not include studio practice uniform, performance leotard, costume, or protective gear that the Participant will wear during practices and official events.
- n) Participate in Club and personnel evaluation activities as requested by BBSC.

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- o) Participate in reasonable educational or non-commercial, promotional activities as may be requested by BBSC or Canada Skateboard.
- p) As a member of BBSC, behave in a courteous and respectful manner and adhere at all times to BBSC's Policies, relating to conduct as amended from time to time.
- q) Use the Discipline and Complaints Policy for remedy of complaints and issues especially where the situation involves the conduct or performance a BBSC employed staff or coach.
- r) Not possess, consume or distribute any recreational drugs as they are forbidden.
- s) Avoid the use of banned substances that contravene the rules of the International Olympic Committee (IOC), and the Canadian Policy on Doping in Sport.
- t) Before, during and after competitions, submit, without prior warning, to unannounced doping-control tests in addition to other prior-notice tests and submit at other times to doping-control testing when requested by BBSC, the Canadian Centre for Ethics in Sport (CCES) or other authorities designated to do so.
- u) Avoid the possession of anabolic drugs and neither supply such drugs to others directly or indirectly nor encourage or condone their use by knowingly aiding in any effort to avoid detection of the use of banned substances or banned performance enhancing practices.
- v) Participate, if asked by BBSC to do so, in any education sessions developed by BBSC in co-operation with Sport Canada and the CCES as well as the necessary NCCP training modules for coach certification if required.
- w) Avoid participating in any competitions where federal government sport policy has determined that such participation is not permitted.
- x) Prior and during competition and any other Club activities, follow and respect all directives given by the national coaching and managerial staff.

SPONSORSHIP AND COMMERCIAL ACTIVITIES

4. BBSC EXPRESSLY RECOGNIZES THE PARTICIPANT'S RIGHT TO ENTER INTO PERSONAL SPONSORSHIP CONTRACTS, ENDORSEMENTS AND BUSINESS RELATIONSHIPS SUBJECT ALWAYS TO THE CONDITIONS AND LIMITATIONS SET OUT BELOW. THE PARTICIPANT HEREBY:

- a) Consents to BBSC using, without charge, on a worldwide basis, in any format or media, the Participant's image, name, nickname, likeness, photo, visual or other identifiable attribute (collectively referred to as "Participant's Attributes") in accordance with the Audio Visual Recording Consent to promote the Club's sponsorship, licensing, advertising and marketing (collectively referred to as the "Club Promotion and Educational Media").
- b) Consents to BBSC using, without charge, on a worldwide basis, the Participant's Attributes to promote skateboarding competitions that are organized and/or sanctioned by BBSC, Canada Skateboard, or other skateboarding organization in which BBSC members or the Club members are participants. This consent shall remain in effect for the duration of the Club Membership and beyond according to the Audio Visual Recording Consent.
- c) Consents to all licensee's or sponsors of BBSC using, without charge, on a worldwide basis, in any format or media, the Participant's Attributes in accordance with the Audio Visual Recording Consent to promote their businesses. All use of the Participant's Attributes by BBSC's licensees and sponsors will be defined and limited by the terms of the licensing or sponsorship agreements in effect with BBSC except that any use of the Participant's Attributes shall not imply a testimonial or endorsement of any product without first obtaining the

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Participant’s authorization. This consent shall remain in effect for the duration of the Club Membership and beyond according to the Audio Visual Recording Consent.

- d) Covenants that the Participant shall not exploit his or her inclusion as a member of the Club to the detriment of BBSC. More specifically, the Participant shall not endorse or promote, as an identifiable member of the Club, the products, goods or services of a sponsor, supplier or supporter of the Participant (referred to as the Participant’s “Personal Sponsors”) in the form of clothing, competition attire or in the form of visible tattoos, temporary tattoos, or such other body applications. Nothing in this subparagraph shall prevent the Participant, in her personal capacity, individual skateboarding performance, and not as an identifiable member of the Club, from endorsing or promoting the various products, goods and services of the Participant’s Personal Sponsors.
- e) Undertakes to not enter into any commercial contract or sponsorship venture associated with the Participant’s role as a member of the Club without first obtaining BBSC’s consent. This consent shall be evidenced by the execution of a written agreement between the Participant and BBSC. BBSC may not grant its consent if the proposed contract or venture conflicts, in the sole opinion of BBSC, with contracts that are, or may be, entered into by BBSC as part of the BBSC Marketing plan.
- f) Covenants that the Participant shall not, while competing (this does not include studio practice uniform, performance leotard, costume, or protective gear that the Participant will wear during practices and official events) or receiving awards as a member of the Club, for the duration of the Term, display, endorse or promote the Participant’s Personal Sponsors and/or their respective products, goods and services.
- g) Agrees to follow and abide by all BBSC rules, Policies and restrictions in place from time to time regarding commercial properties, endorsements, advertising and sponsorships.
- h) Warrant that she has not granted and will not grant to any person or entity during the term of this Agreement an exclusive license to use the Participant’s Attributes which would conflict with this Agreement and/or with the Participant’s participation in BBSC’s marketing plan. Specifically this includes any fashion, gear, technology, health, or other product or service company or organization requesting an exclusive license from the Participant.
- i) Consult with BBSC on any commercial venture which may conflict with BBSC’s marketing plan.

AUDIO VISUAL RECORDING CONSENT

5. I, ACKNOWLEDGE AND AGREE WITH BALLET BALANCE SKATEBOARD CLUB, (“BBSC”), OR SUCCESSOR REPRESENTATIVES, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE OPPORTUNITY FOR ME TO PARTICIPATE IN BBSC ACTIVITIES WHICH INCLUDE THE RECORDINGS DESCRIBED BELOW AND FOR OTHER GOOD AND VALUABLE CONSIDERATION (THE RECEIPT AND SUFFICIENCY OF WHICH I ACKNOWLEDGE), AS FOLLOWS:

- a) The Participant and parent/guardian hereby authorize the photography and visualgraphy of the Participant during all sessions as an insurance and security component of the membership. If something wrong happens we want to know exactly how and why due to the safe sport guidelines. Team members learn how to properly make skateboarding visuals as a side learning of membership. Part of this training involves the Participant operating the cameras from time to time.
- b) I acknowledge the photos and visuals can become part of the training visuals used in the practice training sessions as well as promotional media. Photos and visuals of the Participant pioneers are vital to team cohesion and providing an important historical archive for the future; for this reason; there is no restriction on documenting the club’s teams and members as they pioneer ballet balance freestyle skateboarding.
- c) The undersigned hereby acknowledge that BBSC may use audio visual recordings of Participants during rehearsal practice sessions to promote the club and Participant, and for visual lesson graphics to show how each trick is accomplished in addition to security and safety of the Participants, coaches, and studio.

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d) I acknowledge that there can be no sponsorship for a Participant without a visual of the athlete in action, the club encourages each Participant to record the progression and pioneering of their Ballet Balance Skateboard Club Team using their own camera during sessions. This allows each Participant to review the previous sessions in between to learn from the sessions.

e) Should a Participant receive a contract for a part in a television, internet, motion picture, or other media production, the Participant must make up any sessions missed due to the filming engagement. Participants are encouraged to schedule their media recording outside of normal club session times.

F) I am entitled to enter into this agreement, which will apply to all recordings in which my image appears, and these recordings may or may not be used by BBSC in whole or in part. I acknowledge that BBSC desires from time to time to use photographs, audio recordings, visual recordings, digital images, sketches, notes, written extractions and other forms of recording (collectively, "Recordings") that capture my image, likeness, voice, performance, opinions, name or related personal information (or any or all of these) (collectively, "Image"). This Agreement shall apply to all Recordings, and my Image as it appears in all Recordings, made available to BBSC, whether such Recordings have been made or taken: a) by any representative of BBSC including any past, present or future employee, appointee, advisor, officer, agent, volunteer, contractor, subcontractor, successor, licensee or assignee of BBSC (each, a "Representative"); or b) by me or any other person and submitted by me or any other person on my behalf, and therefore with my consent, to BBSC or a Representative. I further acknowledge and agree that BBSC and its Representatives may, but are under no obligation to, make any Use of the Recordings, in whole or in part. I represent and warrant that this Agreement does not in any way conflict with any existing commitment on my part with respect to the Use or capture of my Image in any Recordings.

g) My image may be used and disclosed for broad purposes and the recordings used in any manner. Unless otherwise agreed in writing, I unconditionally consent, authorize and grant in perpetuity to BBSC and its Representatives all necessary authority, right and license throughout the World, and in their sole discretion, to: a) store and Use my Image as it is captured in the Recordings; and b) Use the Recordings without limitation or restriction. For the purposes of this Agreement, "Use" or "Used" means: a) both commercial and non-commercial use and unlimited disclosure of my Image for public relations, public promotion, advertising, marketing, educational and editorial purposes; b) unlimited use or exploitation of the Recordings for any internal or external purpose, including for public relations, public promotion, advertising, marketing, educational, editorial or any and all other commercial or non-commercial purposes whatsoever, and further includes the right to print, reproduce, copy, distribute, sell, loan, exhibit, display, publish, broadcast or communicate the Recordings in all forms, media and technologies now known or hereafter developed, including via the Internet; and c) the right to alter, change or modify my Image and/or the Recordings or to combine or incorporate all or any parts of my Image and/or the Recordings into other works, create derivative works from my Image and/or the Recordings and the right to use my Image and/or the Recordings alone or in combination with other persons or images, including with the marks and branding of BBSC or its Representatives.

h) I do not own the recordings made by/for BBSC, or my image as it appears in any recordings. I confirm that, as between myself and BBSC, BBSC owns and will retain all right, title and interest throughout the World in and to all Recordings made or taken by it or any of its Representatives, as well as my Image as it appears in any Recordings. I hereby irrevocably and unconditionally assign and grant to BBSC all assignable right, title and interest and waive in favour of BBSC all non-transferable rights and interests, including any "moral rights", that I have or may acquire (including personality and publicity rights) in Recordings made or taken by BBSC or any of its Representatives, and my Image as it is captured or Used in any Recordings. BBSC may license or assign its rights in the Recordings to third parties and I agree that, in such event, the preceding sentence will extend to all such parties and their assignees and licensees.

i) I am not entitled to receive any payment for the use of the recordings or the use of my image in the recordings. Unless otherwise expressly agreed to in writing in advance, no royalties, fees or other form of payment or compensation whatsoever will be provided to me for or in connection with this Agreement or any current or future Use of my Image or the Recordings. BBSC and its Representatives may, but are not obligated to, in their discretion, identify me in connection with their Use of the Recordings or my Image as it is captured in

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the Recordings.

j) I am giving up my right to sue, and I have no right to approve the use of my image or the recordings. I hereby waive my rights and release and agree to hold harmless BBSC and all of its Representatives from any and all claims of any nature whatsoever which I may now or in the future have against any or all of them by reason of any fact or matter in any way relating to or arising from their ownership or Use of my Image or the Recordings, or otherwise relating to the subject matter of this Agreement. I hereby waive any right that I may have to approve, at any time, the manner of Use of the Recordings or the Use or appearance of my Image as it is captured in the Recordings. This indemnification shall survive any termination or expiry of this Agreement.

BBSC / CANADA SKATEBOARD RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY

6. RELEASE OF LIABILITY, WAIVER OF CLAIMS, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT FOR BALLET BALANCE SKATEBOARD CLUB, YOU WAIVE CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS, INCLUDING THE RIGHT TO SUE OR CLAIM COMPENSATION FOLLOWING AN ACCIDENT. IN CONSIDERATION OF THE RIGHT TO PARTICIPATE IN BALLET BALANCE SKATEBOARD CLUB EVENTS, WHICH I ACKNOWLEDGE IS GOOD, VALUABLE AND SUFFICIENT CONSIDERATION, I HEREBY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

a) I acknowledge that Releasees, have not and do not assume any liability for any injury, damage or loss of any nature whatsoever which may occur as a result of any reason during Ballet Balance Skateboard Club activities;

b) I acknowledge that I may be participating in a dangerous sporting activity at a Ballet Balance Skateboard Club practice rehearsal session. Including the inherently dangerous skateboarding activities. I understand that the risk of injury from the activities involved in skateboarding is significant, including the potential for permanent paralysis and death, and while particular rules, equipment, and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk of serious injury does exist;

c) I knowingly and freely assume all such risks, both known and unknown, even if arising from the negligence of the other releasees or others and assume full responsibility for my participation, and I willingly agree to comply with any stated and customary terms and conditions for participation;

d) I waive any and all claims that I have or may in the future have against the releasees, and to release the releasees from any and all liability for any loss, damage, expense or injury, including death, that I may suffer or that my next of kin may suffer, as a result of my presence at or participation in the activities and programs due to any cause whatsoever, including negligence, breach of contract, or breach of any statutory or other duty of care, including any duty of care owed under any applicable occupiers liability legislation on the part of the releasees. I understand that negligence includes failure on the part of releasees to take reasonable steps to safeguard or protect me from the risks, dangers, and hazards associated with the activities and programs;

e) I agree to hold harmless and indemnify the releasees from any and all liability for any damage to property of or personal injury to any third party, resulting from my participation in Ballet Balance Skateboard Club events. I understand that this means I will reimburse the Releasees if a claim is made against them in connection with my participation in Ballet Balance Skateboard Club.

f) I hereby release Releasees from any and all claims, demands, causes of action, losses, expenses, costs, and liability of any nature whatsoever which I may hereafter have against any of them arising out of or in connection with Ballet Balance Skateboard Club.

g) I grant to Ballet Balance Skateboard Club the right to use my name, likeness, portrait, recorded voice, photographs, film and visuals, including the visual submission for digital events in advertising, marketing, or other use, without compensation and without restriction as to duration, geography, media or frequency.

h) Ballet Balance Skateboard Club reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, to require proof

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of identity and/or eligibility (in a form acceptable to the Ballet Balance Skateboard Club – including, without limitation, government-issued photo identification): (i) for the purposes of verifying an individual’s eligibility to participate in team training sessions; (ii) for the purposes of verifying the eligibility and/or legitimacy of an entry (or a purported entry) for the purposes of Ballet Balance Skateboard Club events; and/or (iii) for any other reason that Ballet Balance Skateboard Club deems necessary, in its sole and absolute discretion, for the purposes of administering Ballet Balance Skateboard Club events. Failure to provide such proof to the complete satisfaction of Ballet Balance Skateboard Club within the timeline specified by Ballet Balance Skateboard Club may result in disqualification of the Participant in the sole and absolute discretion of Ballet Balance Skateboard Club.

i) This Agreement and any rights, duties and obligations as between the parties to this Agreement shall be governed and interpreted solely in accordance with the laws of the Province/Territory of British Columbia and no other jurisdiction.

j) Any litigation involving the parties to this Agreement shall be brought solely within the Province of British Columbia and shall be within the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts of the Province of British Columbia.

k) **BALLET BALANCE SKATEBOARD CLUB ENCOURAGES THE USE OF HELMETS AND PROTECTIVE GEAR, REGARDLESS OF PARTICIPANT SKILL LEVEL OR AGE.** All participants must wear a certified properly fitted helmet and wrist guards for all rolling exercises in accordance with the BBSC Helmet and Wrist Guard Policy.

l) The participant and parent/guardian hereby waive all liability of Ballet Balance Skateboarding Club (BBSC), their participants, contractees, coaches, volunteers, or anyone connected with BBSC if the participant gets injured or hurt by skateboarding outside of the club rehearsal practice sessions. The undersigned hereby specifically acknowledge that BBSC liability is waived if the participant at any time in the future gets injured or hurt while skateboarding anywhere across the earth.

RESOLUTION OF DISPUTES

7) **BBSC AND THE PARTICIPANT AGREE THAT ALLEGED BREACHES AND DISPUTES RELATING TO THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE DEALT WITH AS FOLLOWS:**

a) Where the Head Coach, in consultation with the High Performance Committee or other members of BBSC is of the view that the Participant is in breach of any of the provisions of this Agreement, the Participant will be notified immediately in writing.

b) In the event that the alleged breach cannot be remedied satisfactorily, within a reasonable period of time after the Participant has been notified, the matter will be dealt with pursuant to BBSC’s Discipline and Complaints Policy.

c) Where the Participant is of the view that the National Coach, the High Performance Committee and/or any other representative of BBSC is in breach of any of the provisions of this Agreement, she will notify an Executive Committee member or Executive Director in writing. The matter will be dealt with pursuant to BBSC’s Discipline and Complaints Policy.

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NO LIABILITY FOR BBSC / CANADA SKATEBOARD AND PARTICIPANT INDEMNIFICATION

8. THE PARTICIPANT HEREBY:

- a) Acknowledges that sport is potentially dangerous and that there are risks, dangers and hazards inherent in competition and in training, and in preparing for and traveling to and from such competition and training. The Participant acknowledges that she will be undertaking all activities pursuant to this Agreement at her own risk and agrees to assume all risks associated with, and incidental to, the Participant's participation in training and competition as a member of the Club.
- b) Acknowledges that BBSC carries only limited insurance to protect its members in the event of death, injury, damage, loss of income, medical expenses or travel claims. BBSC is not responsible for any medical costs, including extra billing charges over and above Provincial medical health plan benefits. The Participant acknowledges that it is the sole responsibility of the Participant to realistically evaluate her insurance requirements in light of the activities to be undertaken by the Participant and to purchase, at the Participant's sole expense, all additional insurance coverage deemed necessary.
- c) Acknowledges that BBSC shall not be liable to the Participant for any loss or damage to any property of the Participant.
- d) Acknowledges that BBSC shall not be liable to the Participant, or to any other party, including the personal representatives and assigns of the Participant in the event of the Participant's death, for any loss, claims or damages arising from an injury to or death of the Participant or injury to or death of any other person resulting, directly or indirectly, from any activity undertaken by the Participant pursuant to this Agreement.
- e) Agrees to indemnify and hold harmless BBSC and its directors, officers, employees, contractors, volunteers and agents from and against any and all liability, claims, losses, damages, and expenses which BBSC may suffer or incur as a result, directly or indirectly, of any activity undertaken by the Participant during this Agreement and pursuant to this Agreement. This indemnification shall survive any termination or expiry of this Agreement.

ENTIRE AGREEMENT

9. NO OTHER AGREEMENT IMPACTS THIS AGREEMENT; ALL CHANGES MUST BE AGREED IN WRITING; BC LAW APPLIES:

- a) This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, understandings and discussions, whether oral or written, and there are no other warranties, agreements or representations between the parties except as expressly set forth herein.
- b) This Agreement is the entire agreement between the parties relating to the subject matter of this Agreement and any modification must be in writing and signed by BBSC.
- c) This Agreement will be interpreted in accordance with the laws of the Province of British Columbia. This Agreement will be governed by the laws of British Columbia and the laws of Canada applicable therein and the courts of British Columbia sitting in Vancouver will have exclusive jurisdiction over any dispute arising from or relating to this Agreement or its subject matter.
- d) If any provision of this Agreement is void, invalid, illegal or unenforceable by reason of law or public policy, all other provisions of this Agreement will nonetheless remain in force and effect.

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INDEPENDENT LEGAL ADVICE

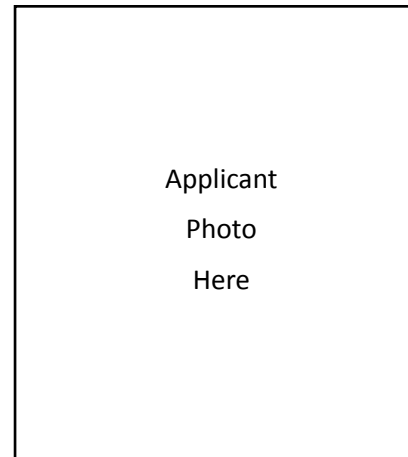

- a) Invite, select and prepare Participants to represent Canada in international skateboarding competitions in accordance with the budget and Policies of BBSC.
- b) Provide administrative services to suit the reasonable needs of the Participant, in accordance to the budget and Policies of BBSC.
- c) Plan and manage training Clubs and competitive activities for the ongoing development of Participants and the Club in accordance with the budget and Policies of BBSC.
- d) Register selected Participants in local, national and international events in which the Club will be attending, in accordance with the budget and Policies of BBSC.
- e) Provide funding for travel, accommodation and meal expenses of Participants participating in training and competitive activities of the Club in accordance with the budget and Policies of BBSC.
- f) Provide, at its cost or at the Participant's cost, accident insurance for the Participant while competing as part of the Club, in accordance with the budget and Policies of BBSC.
- g) Provide team uniforms, apparel, products and other equipment that BBSC requests from Participants to wear, in accordance with the budget and Policies of BBSC. This does not include studio practice uniform, performance leotard, costume, or protective gear that the Participant will wear during practices and official events.
- h) Assist the Participant in obtaining appropriate sport science expertise and medical care to the best of their ability and in accordance with the budget of BBSC. All demands of assistance should be answered in a timely fashion according to the circumstances.
- i) Respect the confidentiality of medical information supplied by the Participant to BBSC's medical staff by not supplying this information to outside parties without consent of the Participant, unless required to do so by law or in accordance with the Canadian Sport anti-doping policies.
- j) Make available through BBSC's website copies of all BBSC Policies, as amended, pertaining to the Club.
- k) Provide an appeal procedure that is in conformity with the principles of natural justice and procedural fairness, which shall include access to independent arbitration through the Sport Dispute Resolution Centre of Canada (SDRCC). Publish the details of this procedure in a prominent manner so that it is freely available to all Participants or any person requesting this information by or on behalf of the Participant.
- l) Provide educational materials and resources on the doping rules of the CCES.
- m) Communicate with Participants both orally and in writing in the language of their choice (French or English).
- n) Publish selection criteria for all Clubs on the BBSC web site. BBSC shall post a Participant status report of Club Participants.
- o) Publish selection criteria for the Participant Assistance Club (AAP) on the BBSC web site at least 3 months prior to the start of the next AAP cycle.
- p) Where possible, provide the Participant with other reasonable assistance.

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OBLIGATIONS OF THE PARTICIPANT

3. THE PARTICIPANT WILL:

- a) Maintain status as a member in good standing of BBSC; abide by all policies, rules and regulations of BBSC; promptly pay all membership dues, health and accident insurance fees when applicable and Club levies associated with training and competition as approved by BBSC.
- b) Hereby warrant that she is a Canadian citizen, or is otherwise eligible to compete for Canada according to BBSC regulations in effect from time to time and that, if the Participant's status changes, the Participant shall forthwith inform BBSC.
- c) Provide BBSC with contact information including: mailing address; telephone number; email address; fax number and cell phone number for the delivery of BBSC's mailings and notices; and provide BBSC with any information which may be requested in order to confirm eligibility of the Participant and test for doping infractions.
- d) Actively participate in all training sessions, competitive activities, evaluation activities, and reporting procedures of the Club under the supervision of the Head Coach.
- e) Avoid any action or conduct that would reasonably be expected to significantly disrupt or interfere with a competition or the preparation for themselves or of any Participant for a competition.
- f) Demonstrate commitment to individual training sessions.
- g) If carded in practice, events or competition, demonstrate commitment to individual training sessions developed in consultation with the Head Coach (and/or designate) and maintain regular contact with the Head Coach (and/or designate) regarding progress in training.
- h) If carded, actively participate in all AAP evaluation activities. Participants will co-operate fully in any evaluation of the AAP that may be conducted by the Minister or anyone authorized to act on the Minister's behalf and provide such data as the person conducting the evaluation considers necessary for the proper conduct of the evaluation.
- i) Present training logs when requested by the coaching staff.
- j) Avoid living in an environment or undertaking in activities which are not conducive to high performance achievement or which pose significant risks to the Participant's health or ability to perform, as reasonably determined by BBSC.
- k) At the earliest possible date, notify the Head Coach in writing of any injury or other legitimate reason that will prevent the Participant from fulfilling any obligations under this Agreement. In the event of injury, the Participant will supply BBSC with a certificate from a medical doctor describing the nature of the injury within one week of the diagnosis of the injury.
- l) Provide pertinent medical information to the Head Coach.
- m) Wear and/or use products as directed by BBSC while engaged in any Club related athletic or athletic-related activities including competition, opening and closing ceremonies, post-competition ceremonies, press conferences, photo sessions, promotional events, and other public appearances; at all times and in the proper manner as directed by BBSC. This does not include studio practice uniform, performance leotard, costume, or protective gear that the Participant will wear during practices and official events.
- n) Participate in Club and personnel evaluation activities as requested by BBSC.

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- o) Participate in reasonable educational or non-commercial, promotional activities as may be requested by BBSC or Canada Skateboard.
- p) As a member of BBSC, behave in a courteous and respectful manner and adhere at all times to BBSC's Policies, relating to conduct as amended from time to time.
- q) Use the Discipline and Complaints Policy for remedy of complaints and issues especially where the situation involves the conduct or performance a BBSC employed staff or coach.
- r) Not possess, consume or distribute any recreational drugs as they are forbidden.
- s) Avoid the use of banned substances that contravene the rules of the International Olympic Committee (IOC), and the Canadian Policy on Doping in Sport.
- t) Before, during and after competitions, submit, without prior warning, to unannounced doping-control tests in addition to other prior-notice tests and submit at other times to doping-control testing when requested by BBSC, the Canadian Centre for Ethics in Sport (CCES) or other authorities designated to do so.
- u) Avoid the possession of anabolic drugs and neither supply such drugs to others directly or indirectly nor encourage or condone their use by knowingly aiding in any effort to avoid detection of the use of banned substances or banned performance enhancing practices.
- v) Participate, if asked by BBSC to do so, in any education sessions developed by BBSC in co-operation with Sport Canada and the CCES as well as the necessary NCCP training modules for coach certification if required.
- w) Avoid participating in any competitions where federal government sport policy has determined that such participation is not permitted.
- x) Prior and during competition and any other Club activities, follow and respect all directives given by the national coaching and managerial staff.

SPONSORSHIP AND COMMERCIAL ACTIVITIES

4. BBSC EXPRESSLY RECOGNIZES THE PARTICIPANT'S RIGHT TO ENTER INTO PERSONAL SPONSORSHIP CONTRACTS, ENDORSEMENTS AND BUSINESS RELATIONSHIPS SUBJECT ALWAYS TO THE CONDITIONS AND LIMITATIONS SET OUT BELOW. THE PARTICIPANT HEREBY:

- a) Consents to BBSC using, without charge, on a worldwide basis, in any format or media, the Participant's image, name, nickname, likeness, photo, visual or other identifiable attribute (collectively referred to as "Participant's Attributes") in accordance with the Audio Visual Recording Consent to promote the Club's sponsorship, licensing, advertising and marketing (collectively referred to as the "Club Promotion and Educational Media").
- b) Consents to BBSC using, without charge, on a worldwide basis, the Participant's Attributes to promote skateboarding competitions that are organized and/or sanctioned by BBSC, Canada Skateboard, or other skateboarding organization in which BBSC members or the Club members are participants. This consent shall remain in effect for the duration of the Club Membership and beyond according to the Audio Visual Recording Consent.
- c) Consents to all licensee's or sponsors of BBSC using, without charge, on a worldwide basis, in any format or media, the Participant's Attributes in accordance with the Audio Visual Recording Consent to promote their businesses. All use of the Participant's Attributes by BBSC's licensees and sponsors will be defined and limited by the terms of the licensing or sponsorship agreements in effect with BBSC except that any use of the Participant's Attributes shall not imply a testimonial or endorsement of any product without first obtaining the

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Participant’s authorization. This consent shall remain in effect for the duration of the Club Membership and beyond according to the Audio Visual Recording Consent.

- d) Covenants that the Participant shall not exploit his or her inclusion as a member of the Club to the detriment of BBSC. More specifically, the Participant shall not endorse or promote, as an identifiable member of the Club, the products, goods or services of a sponsor, supplier or supporter of the Participant (referred to as the Participant’s “Personal Sponsors”) in the form of clothing, competition attire or in the form of visible tattoos, temporary tattoos, or such other body applications. Nothing in this subparagraph shall prevent the Participant, in her personal capacity, individual skateboarding performance, and not as an identifiable member of the Club, from endorsing or promoting the various products, goods and services of the Participant’s Personal Sponsors.
- e) Undertakes to not enter into any commercial contract or sponsorship venture associated with the Participant’s role as a member of the Club without first obtaining BBSC’s consent. This consent shall be evidenced by the execution of a written agreement between the Participant and BBSC. BBSC may not grant its consent if the proposed contract or venture conflicts, in the sole opinion of BBSC, with contracts that are, or may be, entered into by BBSC as part of the BBSC Marketing plan.
- f) Covenants that the Participant shall not, while competing (this does not include studio practice uniform, performance leotard, costume, or protective gear that the Participant will wear during practices and official events) or receiving awards as a member of the Club, for the duration of the Term, display, endorse or promote the Participant’s Personal Sponsors and/or their respective products, goods and services.
- g) Agrees to follow and abide by all BBSC rules, Policies and restrictions in place from time to time regarding commercial properties, endorsements, advertising and sponsorships.
- h) Warrant that she has not granted and will not grant to any person or entity during the term of this Agreement an exclusive license to use the Participant’s Attributes which would conflict with this Agreement and/or with the Participant’s participation in BBSC’s marketing plan. Specifically this includes any fashion, gear, technology, health, or other product or service company or organization requesting an exclusive license from the Participant.
- i) Consult with BBSC on any commercial venture which may conflict with BBSC’s marketing plan.

AUDIO VISUAL RECORDING CONSENT

5. I, ACKNOWLEDGE AND AGREE WITH BALLET BALANCE SKATEBOARD CLUB, (“BBSC”), OR SUCCESSOR REPRESENTATIVES, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE OPPORTUNITY FOR ME TO PARTICIPATE IN BBSC ACTIVITIES WHICH INCLUDE THE RECORDINGS DESCRIBED BELOW AND FOR OTHER GOOD AND VALUABLE CONSIDERATION (THE RECEIPT AND SUFFICIENCY OF WHICH I ACKNOWLEDGE), AS FOLLOWS:

- a) The Participant and parent/guardian hereby authorize the photography and visualgraphy of the Participant during all sessions as an insurance and security component of the membership. If something wrong happens we want to know exactly how and why due to the safe sport guidelines. Team members learn how to properly make skateboarding visuals as a side learning of membership. Part of this training involves the Participant operating the cameras from time to time.
- b) I acknowledge the photos and visuals can become part of the training visuals used in the practice training sessions as well as promotional media. Photos and visuals of the Participant pioneers are vital to team cohesion and providing an important historical archive for the future; for this reason; there is no restriction on documenting the club’s teams and members as they pioneer ballet balance freestyle skateboarding.
- c) The undersigned hereby acknowledge that BBSC may use audio visual recordings of Participants during rehearsal practice sessions to promote the club and Participant, and for visual lesson graphics to show how each trick is accomplished in addition to security and safety of the Participants, coaches, and studio.

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d) I acknowledge that there can be no sponsorship for a Participant without a visual of the athlete in action, the club encourages each Participant to record the progression and pioneering of their Ballet Balance Skateboard Club Team using their own camera during sessions. This allows each Participant to review the previous sessions in between to learn from the sessions.

e) Should a Participant receive a contract for a part in a television, internet, motion picture, or other media production, the Participant must make up any sessions missed due to the filming engagement. Participants are encouraged to schedule their media recording outside of normal club session times.

F) I am entitled to enter into this agreement, which will apply to all recordings in which my image appears, and these recordings may or may not be used by BBSC in whole or in part. I acknowledge that BBSC desires from time to time to use photographs, audio recordings, visual recordings, digital images, sketches, notes, written extractions and other forms of recording (collectively, "Recordings") that capture my image, likeness, voice, performance, opinions, name or related personal information (or any or all of these) (collectively, "Image"). This Agreement shall apply to all Recordings, and my Image as it appears in all Recordings, made available to BBSC, whether such Recordings have been made or taken: a) by any representative of BBSC including any past, present or future employee, appointee, advisor, officer, agent, volunteer, contractor, subcontractor, successor, licensee or assignee of BBSC (each, a "Representative"); or b) by me or any other person and submitted by me or any other person on my behalf, and therefore with my consent, to BBSC or a Representative. I further acknowledge and agree that BBSC and its Representatives may, but are under no obligation to, make any Use of the Recordings, in whole or in part. I represent and warrant that this Agreement does not in any way conflict with any existing commitment on my part with respect to the Use or capture of my Image in any Recordings.

g) My image may be used and disclosed for broad purposes and the recordings used in any manner. Unless otherwise agreed in writing, I unconditionally consent, authorize and grant in perpetuity to BBSC and its Representatives all necessary authority, right and license throughout the World, and in their sole discretion, to: a) store and Use my Image as it is captured in the Recordings; and b) Use the Recordings without limitation or restriction. For the purposes of this Agreement, "Use" or "Used" means: a) both commercial and non-commercial use and unlimited disclosure of my Image for public relations, public promotion, advertising, marketing, educational and editorial purposes; b) unlimited use or exploitation of the Recordings for any internal or external purpose, including for public relations, public promotion, advertising, marketing, educational, editorial or any and all other commercial or non-commercial purposes whatsoever, and further includes the right to print, reproduce, copy, distribute, sell, loan, exhibit, display, publish, broadcast or communicate the Recordings in all forms, media and technologies now known or hereafter developed, including via the Internet; and c) the right to alter, change or modify my Image and/or the Recordings or to combine or incorporate all or any parts of my Image and/or the Recordings into other works, create derivative works from my Image and/or the Recordings and the right to use my Image and/or the Recordings alone or in combination with other persons or images, including with the marks and branding of BBSC or its Representatives.

h) I do not own the recordings made by/for BBSC, or my image as it appears in any recordings. I confirm that, as between myself and BBSC, BBSC owns and will retain all right, title and interest throughout the World in and to all Recordings made or taken by it or any of its Representatives, as well as my Image as it appears in any Recordings. I hereby irrevocably and unconditionally assign and grant to BBSC all assignable right, title and interest and waive in favour of BBSC all non-transferable rights and interests, including any "moral rights", that I have or may acquire (including personality and publicity rights) in Recordings made or taken by BBSC or any of its Representatives, and my Image as it is captured or Used in any Recordings. BBSC may license or assign its rights in the Recordings to third parties and I agree that, in such event, the preceding sentence will extend to all such parties and their assignees and licensees.

i) I am not entitled to receive any payment for the use of the recordings or the use of my image in the recordings. Unless otherwise expressly agreed to in writing in advance, no royalties, fees or other form of payment or compensation whatsoever will be provided to me for or in connection with this Agreement or any current or future Use of my Image or the Recordings. BBSC and its Representatives may, but are not obligated to, in their discretion, identify me in connection with their Use of the Recordings or my Image as it is captured in

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the Recordings.

j) I am giving up my right to sue, and I have no right to approve the use of my image or the recordings. I hereby waive my rights and release and agree to hold harmless BBSC and all of its Representatives from any and all claims of any nature whatsoever which I may now or in the future have against any or all of them by reason of any fact or matter in any way relating to or arising from their ownership or Use of my Image or the Recordings, or otherwise relating to the subject matter of this Agreement. I hereby waive any right that I may have to approve, at any time, the manner of Use of the Recordings or the Use or appearance of my Image as it is captured in the Recordings. This indemnification shall survive any termination or expiry of this Agreement.

BBSC / CANADA SKATEBOARD RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY

6. RELEASE OF LIABILITY, WAIVER OF CLAIMS, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT FOR BALLET BALANCE SKATEBOARD CLUB, YOU WAIVE CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS, INCLUDING THE RIGHT TO SUE OR CLAIM COMPENSATION FOLLOWING AN ACCIDENT. IN CONSIDERATION OF THE RIGHT TO PARTICIPATE IN BALLET BALANCE SKATEBOARD CLUB EVENTS, WHICH I ACKNOWLEDGE IS GOOD, VALUABLE AND SUFFICIENT CONSIDERATION, I HEREBY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

a) I acknowledge that Releasees, have not and do not assume any liability for any injury, damage or loss of any nature whatsoever which may occur as a result of any reason during Ballet Balance Skateboard Club activities;

b) I acknowledge that I may be participating in a dangerous sporting activity at a Ballet Balance Skateboard Club practice rehearsal session. Including the inherently dangerous skateboarding activities. I understand that the risk of injury from the activities involved in skateboarding is significant, including the potential for permanent paralysis and death, and while particular rules, equipment, and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk of serious injury does exist;

c) I knowingly and freely assume all such risks, both known and unknown, even if arising from the negligence of the other releasees or others and assume full responsibility for my participation, and I willingly agree to comply with any stated and customary terms and conditions for participation;

d) I waive any and all claims that I have or may in the future have against the releasees, and to release the releasees from any and all liability for any loss, damage, expense or injury, including death, that I may suffer or that my next of kin may suffer, as a result of my presence at or participation in the activities and programs due to any cause whatsoever, including negligence, breach of contract, or breach of any statutory or other duty of care, including any duty of care owed under any applicable occupiers liability legislation on the part of the releasees. I understand that negligence includes failure on the part of releasees to take reasonable steps to safeguard or protect me from the risks, dangers, and hazards associated with the activities and programs;

e) I agree to hold harmless and indemnify the releasees from any and all liability for any damage to property of or personal injury to any third party, resulting from my participation in Ballet Balance Skateboard Club events. I understand that this means I will reimburse the Releasees if a claim is made against them in connection with my participation in Ballet Balance Skateboard Club.

f) I hereby release Releasees from any and all claims, demands, causes of action, losses, expenses, costs, and liability of any nature whatsoever which I may hereafter have against any of them arising out of or in connection with Ballet Balance Skateboard Club.

g) I grant to Ballet Balance Skateboard Club the right to use my name, likeness, portrait, recorded voice, photographs, film and visuals, including the visual submission for digital events in advertising, marketing, or other use, without compensation and without restriction as to duration, geography, media or frequency.

h) Ballet Balance Skateboard Club reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, to require proof

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of identity and/or eligibility (in a form acceptable to the Ballet Balance Skateboard Club – including, without limitation, government-issued photo identification): (i) for the purposes of verifying an individual’s eligibility to participate in team training sessions; (ii) for the purposes of verifying the eligibility and/or legitimacy of an entry (or a purported entry) for the purposes of Ballet Balance Skateboard Club events; and/or (iii) for any other reason that Ballet Balance Skateboard Club deems necessary, in its sole and absolute discretion, for the purposes of administering Ballet Balance Skateboard Club events. Failure to provide such proof to the complete satisfaction of Ballet Balance Skateboard Club within the timeline specified by Ballet Balance Skateboard Club may result in disqualification of the Participant in the sole and absolute discretion of Ballet Balance Skateboard Club.

i) This Agreement and any rights, duties and obligations as between the parties to this Agreement shall be governed and interpreted solely in accordance with the laws of the Province/Territory of British Columbia and no other jurisdiction.

j) Any litigation involving the parties to this Agreement shall be brought solely within the Province of British Columbia and shall be within the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts of the Province of British Columbia.

k) **BALLET BALANCE SKATEBOARD CLUB ENCOURAGES THE USE OF HELMETS AND PROTECTIVE GEAR, REGARDLESS OF PARTICIPANT SKILL LEVEL OR AGE.** All participants must wear a certified properly fitted helmet and wrist guards for all rolling exercises in accordance with the BBSC Helmet and Wrist Guard Policy.

l) The participant and parent/guardian hereby waive all liability of Ballet Balance Skateboarding Club (BBSC), their participants, contractees, coaches, volunteers, or anyone connected with BBSC if the participant gets injured or hurt by skateboarding outside of the club rehearsal practice sessions. The undersigned hereby specifically acknowledge that BBSC liability is waived if the participant at any time in the future gets injured or hurt while skateboarding anywhere across the earth.

RESOLUTION OF DISPUTES

7) **BBSC AND THE PARTICIPANT AGREE THAT ALLEGED BREACHES AND DISPUTES RELATING TO THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE DEALT WITH AS FOLLOWS:**

a) Where the Head Coach, in consultation with the High Performance Committee or other members of BBSC is of the view that the Participant is in breach of any of the provisions of this Agreement, the Participant will be notified immediately in writing.

b) In the event that the alleged breach cannot be remedied satisfactorily, within a reasonable period of time after the Participant has been notified, the matter will be dealt with pursuant to BBSC’s Discipline and Complaints Policy.

c) Where the Participant is of the view that the National Coach, the High Performance Committee and/or any other representative of BBSC is in breach of any of the provisions of this Agreement, she will notify an Executive Committee member or Executive Director in writing. The matter will be dealt with pursuant to BBSC’s Discipline and Complaints Policy.

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NO LIABILITY FOR BBSC / CANADA SKATEBOARD AND PARTICIPANT INDEMNIFICATION

8. THE PARTICIPANT HEREBY:

- a) Acknowledges that sport is potentially dangerous and that there are risks, dangers and hazards inherent in competition and in training, and in preparing for and traveling to and from such competition and training. The Participant acknowledges that she will be undertaking all activities pursuant to this Agreement at her own risk and agrees to assume all risks associated with, and incidental to, the Participant's participation in training and competition as a member of the Club.
- b) Acknowledges that BBSC carries only limited insurance to protect its members in the event of death, injury, damage, loss of income, medical expenses or travel claims. BBSC is not responsible for any medical costs, including extra billing charges over and above Provincial medical health plan benefits. The Participant acknowledges that it is the sole responsibility of the Participant to realistically evaluate her insurance requirements in light of the activities to be undertaken by the Participant and to purchase, at the Participant's sole expense, all additional insurance coverage deemed necessary.
- c) Acknowledges that BBSC shall not be liable to the Participant for any loss or damage to any property of the Participant.
- d) Acknowledges that BBSC shall not be liable to the Participant, or to any other party, including the personal representatives and assigns of the Participant in the event of the Participant's death, for any loss, claims or damages arising from an injury to or death of the Participant or injury to or death of any other person resulting, directly or indirectly, from any activity undertaken by the Participant pursuant to this Agreement.
- e) Agrees to indemnify and hold harmless BBSC and its directors, officers, employees, contractors, volunteers and agents from and against any and all liability, claims, losses, damages, and expenses which BBSC may suffer or incur as a result, directly or indirectly, of any activity undertaken by the Participant during this Agreement and pursuant to this Agreement. This indemnification shall survive any termination or expiry of this Agreement.

ENTIRE AGREEMENT

9. NO OTHER AGREEMENT IMPACTS THIS AGREEMENT; ALL CHANGES MUST BE AGREED IN WRITING; BC LAW APPLIES:

- a) This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, understandings and discussions, whether oral or written, and there are no other warranties, agreements or representations between the parties except as expressly set forth herein.
- b) This Agreement is the entire agreement between the parties relating to the subject matter of this Agreement and any modification must be in writing and signed by BBSC.
- c) This Agreement will be interpreted in accordance with the laws of the Province of British Columbia. This Agreement will be governed by the laws of British Columbia and the laws of Canada applicable therein and the courts of British Columbia sitting in Vancouver will have exclusive jurisdiction over any dispute arising from or relating to this Agreement or its subject matter.
- d) If any provision of this Agreement is void, invalid, illegal or unenforceable by reason of law or public policy, all other provisions of this Agreement will nonetheless remain in force and effect.

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INDEPENDENT LEGAL ADVICE

10. THE PARTICIPANT INCLUDING PARENT/GUARDIAN CONFIRMS THAT THE PARTICIPANT HAS BEEN RECOMMENDED TO CONSULT A LAW PROFESSIONAL AND OBTAIN INDEPENDENT LEGAL ADVICE PRIOR TO THE EXECUTION OF THIS LEGAL CONTRACT. THE PARTICIPANT CONFIRMS TO BBSC THAT:

- a) The Participant has obtained independent legal advice, or in the alternative,
- b) That the Participant has voluntarily declined to seek independent legal advice despite being given every opportunity to do so.

DURATION OF AGREEMENT
